

“Community First” Scholarship Criteria

The award:

Union Settlement Federal Credit Union’s scholarships are two awards of \$500.00 to be paid jointly to the student and educational institution.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a high school senior pursuing higher education/college with a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Applicant will be enrolled in either a two-or four-year accredited educational institution.
- Applicant must have participated in community service in East Harlem within the last 12 months.
- Applicant must agree to use any scholarship funds awarded only at any accredited educational institution by January 31, 2011.
- Applicant can’t be an employee or a relative of an employee of Union Settlement Federal Credit Union.
- Applicant must agree to attend the Union Settlement FCU’s Annual Meeting in April.

Application Process:

- Applicant must complete the school scholarship application form.
- Applicant must have a letter from an authorized representative associated with the community service activity verifying the student’s participation
- Applicant must submit a 75-100 word typed essay by 3:00pm on **February 26th ,2010**.

- Applicant must include an official transcript documenting student’s GPA

Selecting Process:

Judging will be based on both subjective criteria and weighted, objective criteria. These include academics achievements, extracurricular and community activities, the essay, etc.

Application Deadline:

Applications must be returned to the credit union no later than **February 26th, 2010**.
